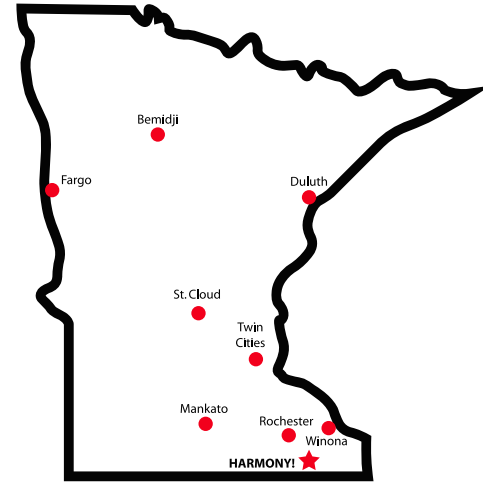

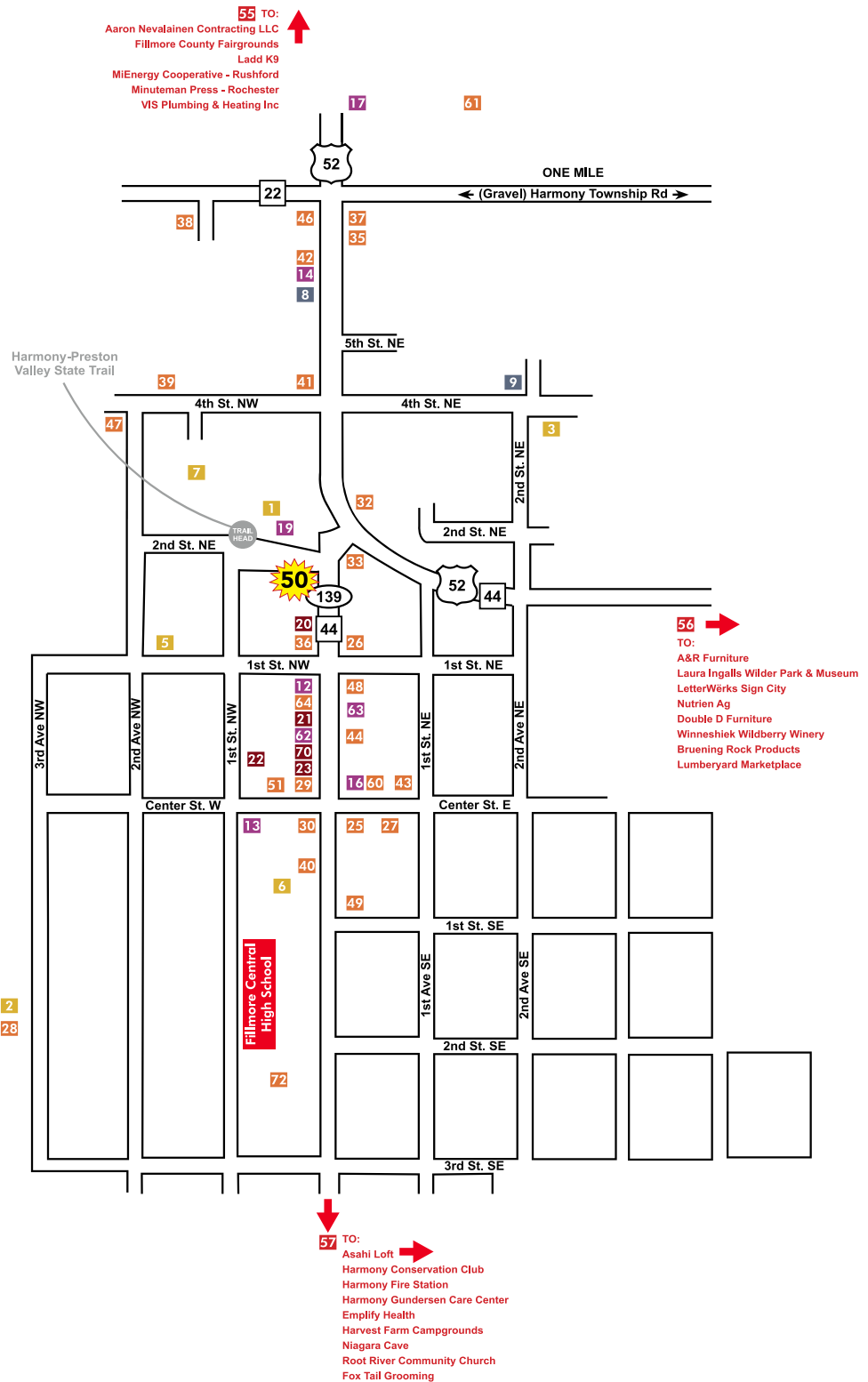

VISIT THE AMISH OF HARMONY

The Harmony area is home to Minnesota's largest Amish settlement. More than 100 Old Order Amish families live in the scenic countryside just east of town, where rolling farmland and quiet country roads reflect a simpler way of life.

The Amish community first settled here in the early 1970s and has grown steadily since. Today, Amish families make their living through farming, construction, and the creation of handcrafted goods. Visitors will find beautifully made baskets, solid wood furniture, homemade jams, woven rugs, quilts, baked goods, and other traditional items available at local farmers' markets and directly from Amish farms.

Over the years, Amish farmers and craftsmen have become an integral part of the Harmony community. Visitors can explore select Amish farms and shops by booking a guided experience through **Amish Tours of Harmony**, located in BReaKeRs in the Village Green.

CAVE EXPLORATION

Harmony is nestled on the edge of the Driftless Area of the Upper Midwest - a rare landscape untouched by the last glaciers. As a result, this region features dramatic limestone bluffs, rolling hills, natural springs, winding creeks, sinkholes, and an impressive network of underground caves.

Two of the area's most popular caves are **Niagara Cave**, located just south of Harmony, and Mystery Cave in nearby Forestville State Park. Niagara Cave is consistently rated among the top caves in the United States and offers guided tours showcasing stunning rock formations, an underground waterfall, and fascinating geological history.

Did you know? More than 400 weddings have been performed inside Niagara Cave since 1935, making it one of the most unique wedding venues in Minnesota.

Above ground, Niagara Cave also features an 18-hole mini golf course (with holes 1-9 wheelchair accessible), along with gemstone and fossil mining – a hands-on favorite for kids and families.

KARST INTERPRETIVE SITE

The Harmony Visitor Center is open April through October and serves as a gateway to understanding the unique landscape of Southeast Minnesota. Inside, visitors can explore exhibits highlighting Harmony's history, the region's distinctive karst environment, and fascinating local fossils.

Just behind the Visitor Center, the Harmony-Preston Valley State Trail leads to the Harmony Karst Interpretive Site. A short walk brings you to a striking sinkhole – a visible example of the geological features that shape this region. Educational signage explains how sinkholes form, why they are common in the Driftless Area, and the importance of protecting these fragile natural systems.

Karst landscapes primarily occur in carbonate rock and cover nearly one-eighth of the Earth's land surface. In our region, karst features include sinkholes, springs, disappearing streams, and caves – all contributing to the distinctive beauty of Harmony's Bluff Country setting.

RECREATION & PARKS

Harmony offers four well-maintained parks and playgrounds, providing space for families to gather, kids to explore, and visitors to relax and enjoy the outdoors.

Selvig Park, located just south of Main Street, is home to **Harmony's Veteran's Memorial** and serves as a central green space for the community. The park features playground equipment, a picnic shelter, gazebo, and public restrooms, making it a welcoming spot for a midday break or community events.

Trailhead Park, located near the Visitor Center along the **Harmony-Preston Valley State Trail**, has become a favorite summer destination. The park features picnic areas, large interactive Harmony Freenotes percussion instruments, and the **Harmony Splash Pad**, which operates seasonally from Memorial Day through Labor Day. In 2025, the **Bruce Bigalk Memorial Pavilion** was dedicated at Trailhead Park, adding additional gathering space for families, events, and trail users. Visitors can also borrow equipment from the Visitor Center to enjoy the free 9-hole disc golf course located on-site.

North Park includes playground equipment, a picnic shelter, and easy access to the golf course, offering recreation for all ages in one convenient location. **Harmony Golf Club** is an open-to-the-public nine hole course. It offers a clubhouse, event space and multiple patios to enjoy.

Cardinal Park is located at the **Harmony Community Center and Public Library**. In addition to playground equipment and open green space, the park includes community garden plots and provides direct access to both the community center and library, making it a hub for year-round activity.

Whether you're visiting for the weekend or enjoying everyday life in Harmony, our parks offer something for everyone.



LODGING & CAMPING

Harmony offers a variety of accommodations for overnight and extended stays, all within close proximity to restaurants, shopping, a movie theatre, grocery store, distillery, and the bike trail. Visitors quickly settle into the relaxed rhythm of life in our small, friendly town – and we're confident you'll enjoy your stay.

The Asahi Loft is a private, tranquil Japanese-style bed and breakfast. Two short term apartments above **Seed & Stone** at **Thirty9Main** are scheduled to open in 2026, adding additional downtown lodging options.

Harmony is also home to the **Country Lodge Inn**, offering 25 ground-level rooms conveniently located on Highway 52, just around the corner from downtown.

For those who prefer the outdoors, **Harmony's Municipal Campground** offers grassy sites with electric and water hookups. **Harvest Farm Campground**, located just south of Harmony on the Upper Iowa River, features outdoor and water activities, an onsite spa, and rental cabins for guests without an RV or tent.

ARTS & HISTORY

The **Laura Ingalls Wilder Park & Museum** is located about 20 minutes south of Harmony in Burr Oak, Iowa. Laura Ingalls Wilder and her family lived there in the 1870s, and the town is the birthplace of her sister, Grace – making it a meaningful stop for fans of the Little House stories and American history.

In Harmony, the **Harmony Area Historical Society** has created an historic signage walking tour of downtown. As you stroll through town, history comes alive through photographs and stories from the past. Pick up a tour map at the **Harmony Visitor Center** to begin your walk.

The Historical Society also hosts rotating exhibits at the Visitor Center and Harmony Community Center, highlighting local heritage and the region's unique geology. Visitors can learn more about karst landscapes and sink-hole formation at the interpretive site along the bike trail.


The **McMichael Grain Elevator**, located near the trailhead, was recently added to the National Register of Historic Places as part of ongoing efforts to preserve Harmony's agricultural and railroad heritage.

AMISH SHOPS

Surrounding the Harmony area, many Amish craftspeople welcome visitors to their home-based businesses (closed Sundays), offering a glimpse into a tradition of skilled workmanship and simple living.

DINING & SPIRITS

Harmony is home to several independently owned restaurants, each offering its own distinctive flavors and atmosphere. On Main Avenue, **On The Crunchy Side American Bar & Eatery**, offers homemade burgers, pizzas, sandwiches, salads, soups, and entrées – elevated pub food at its finest.

Estelle's Eatery & Bar is a neighborhood favorite featuring from-scratch cooking and a seasonally rotating menu, along with a strong selection of craft beers, wines, and cocktails. **Gabby Lou's Kitchen**, Harmony's newest dining establishment, serves breakfast six days a week and lunch on week-days – be sure to try the homemade cinnamon rolls.

Harmony Spirits, a craft distillery in the heart of downtown, sits right along the bike trail route through town. Its tasting room offers a welcoming place to enjoy artisan spirits, and guests are welcome to bring takeout from local restaurants to enjoy during their visit.

Winneshiek Wildberry Winery, located about 25 minutes from Harmony in rural Decorah, offers a scenic countryside setting to sample their award-winning fruit wines.

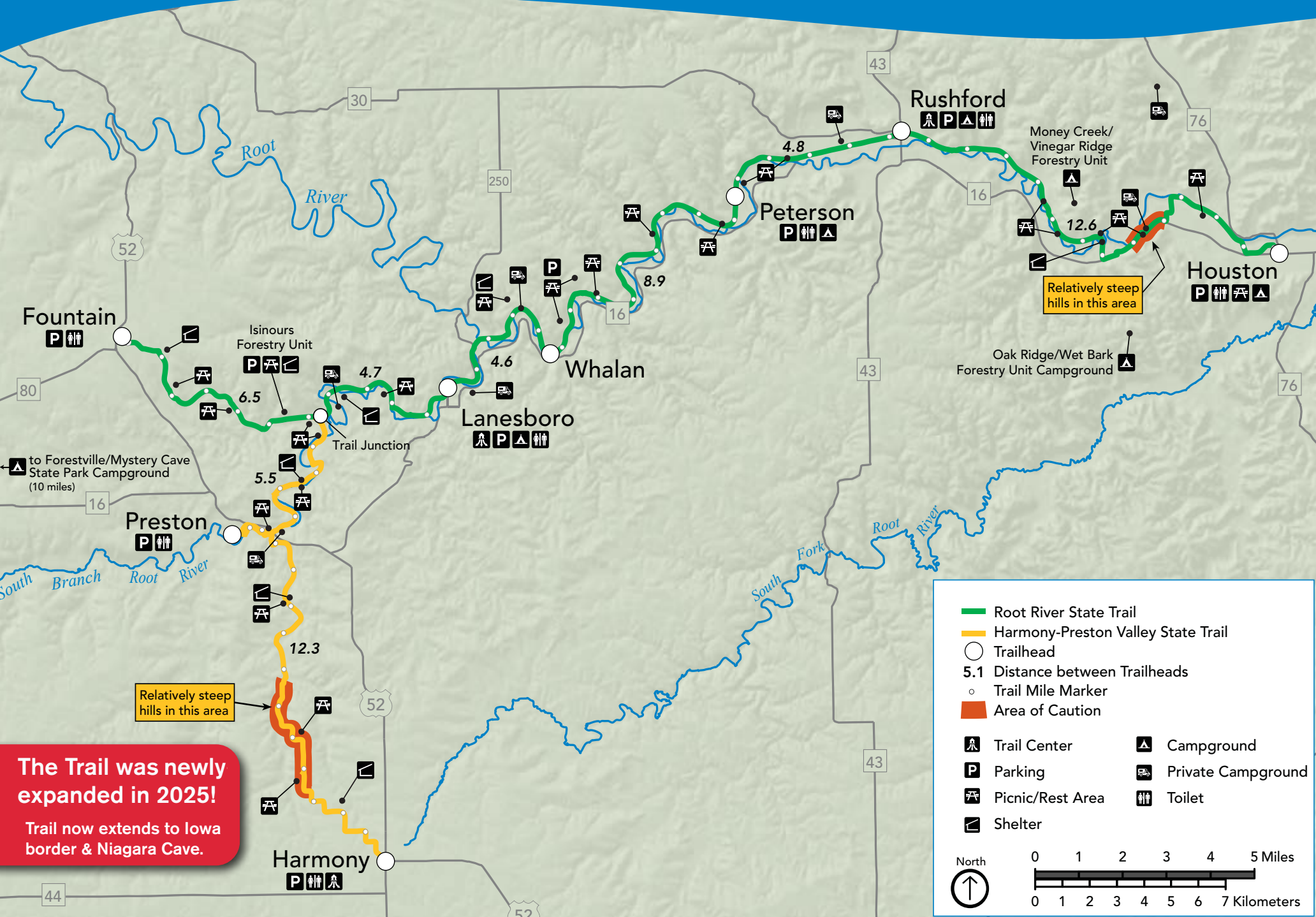

BIKING

The Harmony-Preston Valley State Trail begins right behind Harmony's Visitor Center and connects seamlessly to more than 60 miles of paved, DNR-maintained trail throughout the Root River Trail system. This beautifully maintained trail winds through wooded stretches, rolling hills, pastoral farmland, and along spring-fed Camp Creek, offering a peaceful and picturesque ride for cyclists of all ages and skill levels.

With the completion of a six-mile extension in 2025, riders can now travel from downtown Harmony south to Niagara Cave and all the way to the Iowa border - expanding access and scenic riding opportunities.

Harmony's trailhead area features convenient amenities including a picnic shelter, playground, splash pad, 9-hole disc golf course, Visitor Center, and parking – making it an ideal starting point for a day outdoors.

Through a partnership with the Root River Trail Towns organization and Fillmore County's Statewide Health Improvement Program, Harmony participates in a regional Bike Share Program. Bikes are available free of charge at the Visitor Center during operating hours (10 a.m. to 3 p.m., May through September). Visitors may bring their own helmet or borrow one when checking out a bike.

SENIOR ACTIVITIES

Golden Happenings of Harmony is an active senior group that meets regularly at the Harmony Community Center. The organization offers outings, workshops, shared meals, informational sessions, and opportunities for fellowship.

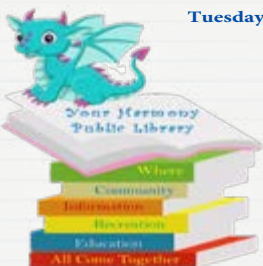
